This workshop for DCTs includes a discussion facilitated by Randall Wyatt, Ph.D. A guest presenter is Dr. Heather Yardley who will talk about APPIC changes/updates for internships. Questions from attendees will also be addressed.

The theme is the future of psychology. This workshop will focus on changes, updates and revisions to internship and the internship application process. The changes to internship training in recent years has been enormous regarding telehealth, reimbursement, interview process and application process (Becker, 2017).

These changes present challenges to students in training and DCTs and also have created new opportunities but also greater stress and attention to the future of health service psychology. (American Psychologist, 2020). Lastly, the importance of sharing struggles and solutions in this NCSPP community and locally will be emphasized.
